Flights

The league will be divided into 4 or 5 flights. All flights will be played from the gold or silver tees. If you turn 80 during the current calendar year, you are eligible to tee off from the silver tees. If you qualify to use the silver tees, you must use them for the remainder of that year. Exception: You may choose to return to the gold tees only once during that year. The flights will be divided by handicap, as equally as possible. The flight schedule will be posted on the schedule board in the Clubhouse each week.

Flight Prizes

Prizes will be awarded weekly as follows: 1st place—\$15.00, 2nd place \$10.00, and 3rd place \$5.00. Ties will be divided as equally as possible.

Hole Prizes

There will be eight (8) hole prizes each week. Players are responsible for recording their name on the hole sigh. Winners of each hole will receive \$5.00

2022 SEJC Appreciation

Shamrock Hills has agreed to host a points accumulation competition again the year. Points will be awarded for participation as well as performance. At the conclusion of the season, the top ten point winners will all receive golf related prizes. This competition is sponsored solely by Shamrock Hills at no additional cost to the members. Weekly results will be posted in the pro shop and website.

Membership

Membership_fee for the 2022 season will be \$60.00 per person. Membership fees must be paid prior to play in order to be eligible for any prize activity.

Golf Fees

Green fees will be \$15.00 for Walkers and \$28.00 for Riders. Weekly fees should be paid for in the pro shop when making the turn on number 9.

Team Game Procedures

We will have at least three (4) team games during the 2022 season. Member feedback for the upcoming seasons is welcome.

A separate procedure for team games will be published with each game.

Guests

Guests are not eligible for prizes when playing. No guests players will be allowed to participate during a team game.

Dollar Day

Shamrock Hills will sponsor an occasional SEJC Dollar Day in the snack bar. On this specified day, SEJC members will be able to purchase all beverages (beer will be \$2.00 each) and hot dogs at \$1.00 each for that day.



Committee

The Committee will consist of Officers of the League. The president, treasurer, and other officers. The Committee will be responsible for awarding prizes, setting up weekly schedules, and coordinating weather delays and /or cancellation decisions. Any questions or disputes not covered in the bylaws and information will be decided by the committee on a case-by-case basis.

Attendance - Don't be a NO SHOW

No member is expected to attend every week, but some notification of absence is needed. A "will not play' sheet will be available to sign out the weeks a member knows that he will be absent. You may also send an email to SEJCgolf@gmail.com to report your absence or request infofmation. If a last-minute absence is unavoidable, a call to one of the pairing officers before 8:00 p.m. the night before, or a call to the pro shop 816-537-6556 anytime before starting time the morning of play would be appreciated. A member that is a **NO SHOW**, will not be eligible for flight prizes the following week. However, the member will be counted for annual participation points. His score will count towards his handicap and he will be eligible for the monument prizes that week.

Handicap

The handicapping system will be modeled after the USGA system and be established from the gold and silver tees.

SEJC Rules

Golf is a game of honor. Our rules in the SEJC Senior League are very lenient and are changed to assist the pace of play. Mulligans are not allowed and relief must be in the same cut.

All conceded putts must be within the leather of a regular putter, not a long or belly putter.

Golfers may play the ball up.

Golfers 3 over par on a hole must pick up and record 3 over par on that hole.

Ball out of bounds or lost ball: play as a Hazard, on line from original position, no closer to the hole. One stroke Penalty.

Immoveable obstruction: one club length relief not nearer the hole on the same line.

Water hazard, drop ball on green side of the water hazard one club length. (1) stroke penalty

Sand traps— play ball as it lies (you may smooth the sand with your foot and place) or remove from trap at least one club length behind the trap. (1) stroke penalty

Course Reminders

Observe all Enter and Exit Signs. Park all carts on cart path by greens and tees.

Repair ball marks and rake sand traps.

Team Events

We will play at least four team games during the season. The cost for these games will be \$5.00 per person per event.

Hole in One Club

There will be a sign-up sheet available for the "Hole in One Club" near the board prior to League play each week. Cost to join will be \$1.00 per golfer. When a Hole in One is made the pot will be awarded on that day. If there is more than one hole in one on the same day, the pot with be divided equally. When the hole in one pot is awarded, there will be a new hole in one sign up sheet started for the next week. You must be a current sign-up participant to the win the pot.

Weekly Golf Skins

Participation in the weekly skins are awarded Within flights on net scores only. Participation is optional at a cost of \$5.00 per person. Payouts will be awarded the following week. Winners within a flight will split prize money equally.
